The 2017 Martha's Vineyard vintage showcases incredible concentration from this warm weather vintage; notes of ripe black fruit, dark chocolate, and sweet bay are lifted and enjoyed with the robust yet soft tannin and mouthwatering bright acidity. Harvested on October 3rd and October 4th, we are pleased with the balanced structure and vibrant aromatics this vintage demonstrates.
