The purpose behind the Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is to create a wine that is representative of Napa Valley and to highlight all the qualities that make this area one of the world's premier wine growing regions. We continue to craft this wine to be a 100% Cabernet Sauvignon blend and is made in the signature Heitz style to be fresh, elegantly structured, and built with the option for aging or enjoying upon release.

VINTAGE NOTES

The 2017 vintage was one of exceptional quality for Heitz Cellar. Although we saw some warmer weather during the growing season, our traditional method of winemaking placed an natural emphasis on harvesting early to maintain natural acidity and preserves the fresh characteristics of the vinetage. The concentration and body of the 2017 vintage will make this an increadible wine to drink upon release and will continue to reward with cellar aging.
