The Heitz Cellar Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from our vineyards throughout the Napa Valley, each of which contributes different sensory attributes to the final blend. The purpose behind the Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is to create a wine that is representative of Napa Valley and to highlight all the qualities that make this area one of the world's premier wine growing regions. We continue to craft this wine to be a 100% Cabernet Sauvignon blend and is made in the signature Heitz style to be fresh, elegantly structured, and built with the option for aging or enjoying upon release.

VINTAGE NOTES

The 2018 vintage was one of exceptional quality for Heitz Cellar. The cooler to moderate temperatures during the growing season allowed us to balance sugar and phenolic maturity in the fruit while maintaining natural acidity to help preserve the fresh characteristics of the vintage. The elegance and balanced structure of the 2018 vintage will make this an incredible wine to drink upon release and will continue to reward with cellar aging.
