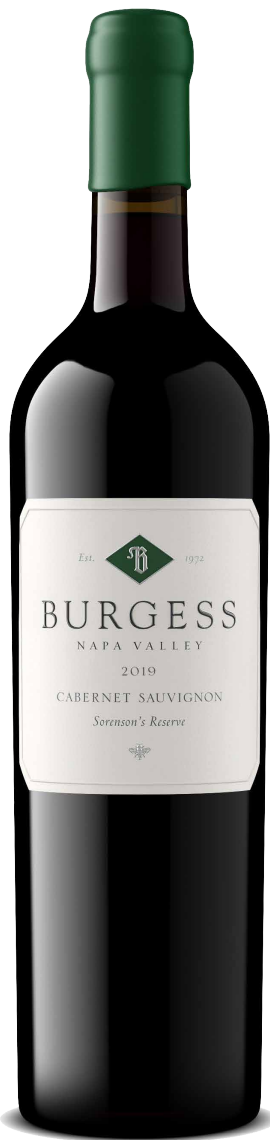

SORENSON ESTATE VINEYARD: CABERNET SAUVIGNON

First planted in 1872 by Swiss-Italian immigrants, Sorenson Vineyard has served as the beating heart of Burgess for more than 150 years. Climbing 800-1000 feet above sea level, this vineyard is carved into the western-facing slopes of Howell Mountain, overlooking the Napa Valley below. The landscape is dotted with large boulders on the “Konocti Series Volcanics” soil, a very densely compacted volcanic ash, as pines and redwoods surround the vineyard, becoming immersed in morning fog during the harvest months.

VINTAGE INFORMATION

Vintage 2019 was a warmer growing season than the previous year. A wet spring eased into a long, mild summer with very few heat spikes and moderate temperatures in August and September. 2019 wines showcase great color, pure fruit flavors, and soft tannins. Our Sorenson's Reserve reflects these characteristics and showcases a ripe and lush style that still preserves the freshness from this mountain site.

TASTING NOTES

Black currant, blackberry and dark plums are complemented by notes of cedar, spice and savory characteristics. Rosemary and thyme lend complexity and freshness to the wine, and the finish is characterized by fine-grained tannins.
