2019 MARTHA'S VINEYARD CABERNET SAUVIGNON OAKVILLE, NAPA VALLEY

Hidden in the shadows of the Mayacamas Mountains on the alluvial fan of western Oakville, Martha's Vineyard continues to embody the pedigree of being named the first single vineyard-designated wine in Napa Valley. Farmed and vinified exclusively by Heitz Cellar over the last 58 years, Martha's Vineyard continues to set the standard for classic, ageworthy Cabernet Sauvignon from the Napa Valley.

VINTAGE NOTES:

2019 started with abundant winter rainfall, allowing the soils to maintain late soil moisture, giving the vines a fantastic start to the growing season. The long, warm summer was even and consistent and marked by the classic, cool foggy mornings that helps our vineyards maintain their vibrant and expressive characteristics. We started picking Martha's Vineyard on October 11th and finished picking on October 24th. Overall, the incredible growing season led to wines with bright acidity, great structure with soft tannins, and brilliant, distinct aromatics. The 2019 vintage will be remembered as another wonderful growing season in Napa Valley.
