



2022 NAPA VALLEY CABERNET SAUVIGNON

The Heitz Cellar Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from our vineyards throughout the Napa Valley, with components of each contributing different sensory attributes to the final blend. The purpose behind the Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is to create a wine that is representative of Napa Valley and to highlight all the qualities that make this area one of the world's premier wine growing regions. We continue to craft this wine to be a 100% Cabernet Sauvignon blend and made in the signature Heitz style to be fresh, elegantly structured, and built with the option for aging or enjoying upon release.

VINTAGE NOTES

2022 is a unique harvest in Napa Valley history, punctuated by a significant heat event in early September. However, the way we farm at Heitz meant that not only was most of our fruit harvested before the heat, but our elkhorn and California sprawl trellising gave the grapes a lot of natural shade, and helped them retain their integrity. For this reason, a lot of our fruit came through the heat unscathed. We also used an optical sorter in 2022 to ensure that only perfect fruit made it into the fermenters.
