Intended to be an exceptional entry point into the classic Heitz style and to highlight all the qualities that make Napa Valley one of the world's premier wine growing regions. Always crafted to be a 100% Cabernet Sauvignon blend and made in the signature Heitz style to be fresh, elegantly structured, and built with the option for aging or enjoying upon release.

### VINTAGE NOTES

2019 started off with an abundance of winter rain and left the vineyards with late soil moisture to pull from throughout the growing season. A long, mild summer was complemented by the foggy mornings that Napa Valley is known for, allowing for even ripening, brilliant preservation of acidity, and development of soft, yet structured tannins. The quality that we see from the 2019 vintage is promising and we look forward to watching this wine develop for years to come.

Aged for three years in a combination of old and new French oak barrels, ranging from 228 to 12,000L. Followed by a minimum of one year of bottle aging before release.
