Intended to be an exceptional entry point into the classic Heitz style and to highlight all the qualities that make Napa Valley one of the world's premier wine growing regions. Always crafted to be a 100% Cabernet Sauvignon blend and made in the signature Heitz style to be fresh, elegantly structured, and built with the option for aging or enjoying upon release.

VINTAGE NOTES

2021 was an outstanding vintage in Napa Valley, one of the best in the last two decades. This was thanks primarily to a very dry year without excessive heat spikes that resulted in low yields and small, intensely-flavored berries. We brought in the lion's share of the fruit for this blend before the end of September. The 2021 is in a ripe but fresh style, with polished tannins and ample acidity that will serve well for medium to long-term cellaring.
