ESTATE VINEYARD

CABERNET SAUVIGNON AND MERLOT

- Planted in the 1870s by Swiss-Italian immigrants, our estate on Howell Mountain is southwest facing with a 27% slope.
- The soils are comprised of densely compacted volcanic ash with large granitic stones.

HAYMAKER VINEYARD

PETIT VERDOT AND MALBEC

- Acquired by Burgess Cellars in 1987, Haymaker Vineyard sits on the opposite side of Howell Mountain facing east, with a slope averaging 20%.
- Its soil composition mirrors the estate's, with bands of uplifted marine sediments.

TASTING NOTES //

The reserve wines for Burgess are produced with grapes from the oldest vines on our 1880 Estate vineyard, planted in 1979. The wine has an unctuous mouth-coating texture punctuated with dried black plums and caramelized blackberry. Earthy aromas of cigar humidor and baked clay on the palate culminate in a velvety tannic finish.

FERMENTATION: All components fermented separately in stainless steel

VARIETAL COMPOSITION: 85% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Petit Verdot, 2.5% Malbec, 2.5% Merlot
