- Founded in 1972, Burgess preserves a vineyard legacy that began in the 19th century. Known as Souverain from 1943-1972, Warren Winiarski, Mike Grgich, and Paul Draper begin their careers here.
- The fruit for Contadina hails from our estate vineyards Quartz Creek and St. Andrews on the western benchland and valley series.
- The Italian word for female farmer, Contadina is an homage to the original Swiss-Italian farming families that first planted the Sorenson vineyard in the 1870s.
