Burgess Contadina is primarily sourced from Sorenson’s Vineyard, first planted in 1872 by Swiss-Italian immigrants and the heart of Burgess wines for more than 150 years. Climbing 800–1000 feet above sea level, this vineyard is carved into the western-facing slopes of Howell Mountain, overlooking the Napa Valley below.
