Sorenson's Vineyard, first planted in 1872 by Swiss-Italian immigrants has been the heart of Burgess wines for more than 150 years. Climbing 800–1000 feet above sea level, this vineyard is carved into the western-facing slopes of Howell Mountain, overlooking the Napa Valley below. The landscape is dotted with large boulders on the Konocti Series Volcanics soil, a very densely compacted volcanic ash, with pines and redwoods outlining the perimeter of the vineyard.
