- A blend only produced once by Joe Heitz in 1969 before current winemaker, Brittany Sherwood, re-introduced this wine in 2018.
- Over 40% of the blend is sourced from Martha's Vineyard, lending the characteristic eucalypt and rich fruit notes.
- Heitz estate vineyards, Trailside Vineyard in Rutherford and Linda Falls on Howell Mountain, complete the blend making this wine the most unique Napa Valley expression.
