The varying, distinctive landscape of the parcels included in this Cabernet Sauvignon allow for something very complex to come together. Each unique parcel occupies a distinct terrain, covering much of the Napa Valley with variations in slope and elevation. This wine is made from Cabernet sourced between elevations of 870–1,900 feet and Merlot sourced at 1,850–2,200 feet.
