The varying, distinctive landscape of the parcels included in this Cabernet Sauvignon allow for something very complex to come together. Each unique parcel occupies a distinct terrain, covering much of the Napa Valley with variations in slope and elevation. This wine is made from Cabernet sourced between elevations of 870 – 1,900 feet and Merlot sourced at 1,850 – 2,200 feet.
