"The Promiscua bottling is a blend of Sorenson and Quartz Creek fruit aged for 20 months in 60% new French oak. It combines the grip and structure of Sorenson with the elegance and prettiness of Quartz Creek. As the highest-volume wine in the lineup, it will be the most widely available on the market. In 2022, this is a full-bodied expression with exceptionally ripe Bing cherry and black berry fruit, layered with nuanced rose petal florals and crunchy pomegranate seed tension. The bold, powerful tannins build through the long, mouthwatering finish, carried by bright, food-friendly acidity. While all Burgess wines pair beautifully with food, this bottling is especially suited to be enjoyed throughout an entire meal, making it one of the most versatile and compelling wines of the vintage."
