2021 FORGERON PINOT NOIR



A unique collaboration between Master Sommelier Carlton McCoy Jr. and Winemaker Nico Cueva, Haynes Vineyard is a historic site producing wines of intent with a sense of place that tell the story of the land. Focusing on Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, the Haynes wines are vineyard designated single-vineyard bottlings made from historic vines planted in 1968 in the heart of the Coombsville AVA.

TASTING NOTES

Floral, spicy, and aromatic, it has the structure of Burgundy but with sun-kissed fruit that rounds out the palate. Planted in 1968 with Louis Martini clones, these vines can live in the world of restraint even in years with heat spikes. Whole cluster style Pinot Noir with subtle oak aging. Higher acidity due to the cool vineyard site produces a fully ripe and balanced Pinot Noir.
