2022 FORGERON CHARDONNAY

A unique collaboration between Master Sommelier Carlton McCoy Jr. and Winemaker Nico Cueva, Haynes Vineyard is a historic site producing wines of intent with a sense of place that tell the story of the land. Focusing on Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, the Haynes wines are vineyard designated single-vineyard bottlings made from historic vines planted in 1967 and 1968 in the heart of the Coombsville AVA.

TASTING NOTES

Old Vine Chardonnay produced from the Haynes Vineyard, planted in 1967. The vineyard site produces mineral driven wines from the coolest microclimate in the Napa Valley. Reminiscent of Burgundian style Chardonnay, the Haynes Forgeron Chardonnay is made to age for many years to come.
