## *2024 SHV Chardonnay*

Founded in 1951 as Napa Valley's first post-Prohibition winery, Stony Hill became one of America's earliest "cult" estates, earning renown for wines defined by mineral intensity and remarkable longevity.

Fred and Eleanor McCrea, founders of Stony Hill, made many dear friends and mentored a lot of new winegrowers in their decades-long careers on Spring Mountain.

Their passion for cool-climate, mineral-and-citrus-driven Chardonnay led them to introduce a Chardonnay bottling in the 1980s called "SHV".

Our 2024 Stony Hill SHV Chardonnay is made from fruit from pedigreed, cool climate sites like our estate.
