Founded in 1951 as Napa Valley's first post-Prohibition winery, Stony Hill became one of America's earliest "cult" estates, earning renown for wines defined by mineral intensity and remarkable longevity.

Founders Fred and Eleanor McCrea's passion for cool-climate, terroir-driven wines led them to introduce a bottling in the 1980s called "SHV". It was a nod to their friends and neighbors, a way to work with vineyards they admired.

100% Cabernet Sauvignon, SHV Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from Stony Hill Vineyard, Ink Grade Vineyard, and Linda Falls Vineyard. This cuvée

The full-bodied palate offers firmly framed yet integrated tannins, bright acidity and a luscious, taut and nervy finish. 60% fruit sourced from Howell Mountain. Give it some time in the bottle for maximum pleasure. Drinkable now but best from 2030."
